Building an A-Frame

Climate Smart Agriculture (CSA) Brief No. 7 for Agricultural Field Officers

What is an A-Frame?

The A-Frame is a tool which can be made at home from local resources. It is called an A-Frame because it looks like the English letter "A". The A-Frame is used for marking out horizontal lines, or contours, across a slope. It is also possible to make a collapsible A-frame.

Materials needed to make an A-Frame

- ✓ Two (2) pieces of wood/bamboo, each about five (5') feet long.
- ✓ One piece of wood/bamboo about three (3') feet long
- ✓ A piece of twine and nails.
- A heavy stone or bolt

Step-by-step process:

- 1. Lay the sticks out in the shape of the English letter "A";
- 2. To join the pieces use nails or string;
- 3. From the top nail, hang a thin string with a heavy stone or a bolt tied at the bottom;
- 4. On level ground, make a mark where the feet of the two longer pieces of wood touch the ground;
- 5. Then make a mark 'a' where the weighted string touches the horizontal stick;
- 6. Make two marks on the ground where the sticks touch the ground;
- 7. Without moving the marks on the ground, lift the A-Frame, turn it around and place it so the opposite legs are in the same place on the marks on the ground;
- 8. Again, mark 'b' where the string touches the horizontal stick:
- 9. Now there are 2 marks, 'a' and 'b'. Make a third mark, 'c', exactly in between 'a' and 'b'. When the string touches 'a', you will know that the legs are exactly on level ground.
